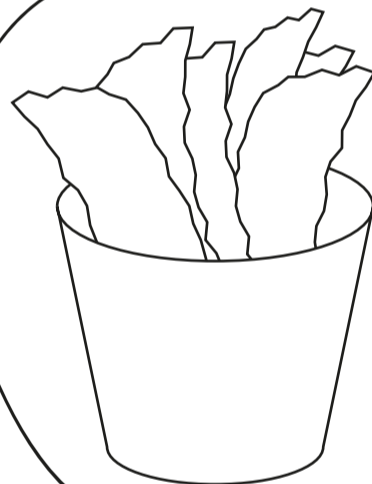


Create your very own nonsense poem or song!

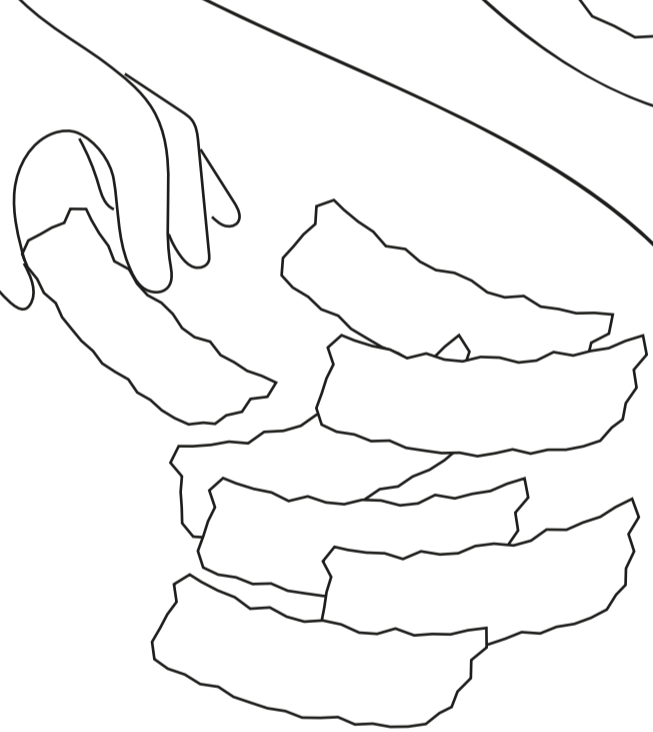
Write out some random words and/or cut words out of old magazines and flyers

Select 10-15 words - you can choose not to look or peek if you don't want to

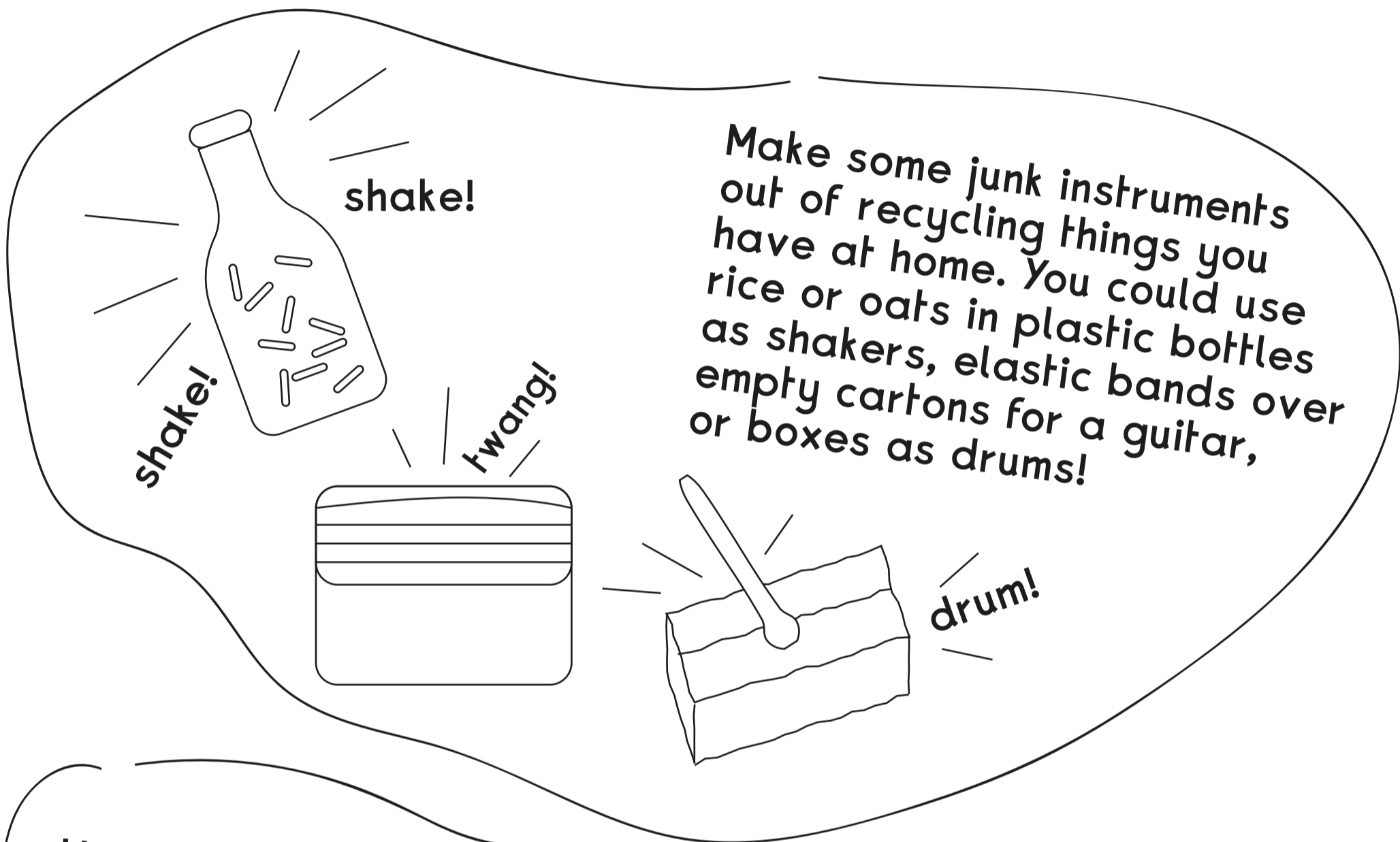
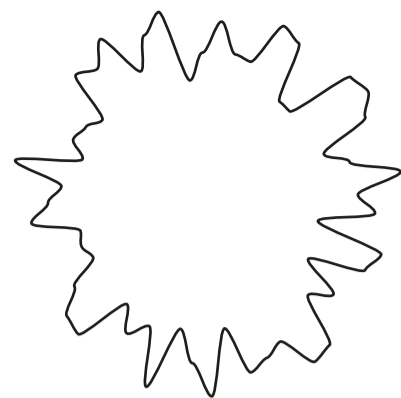
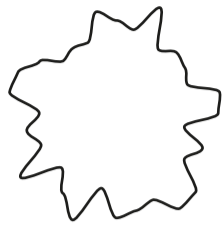

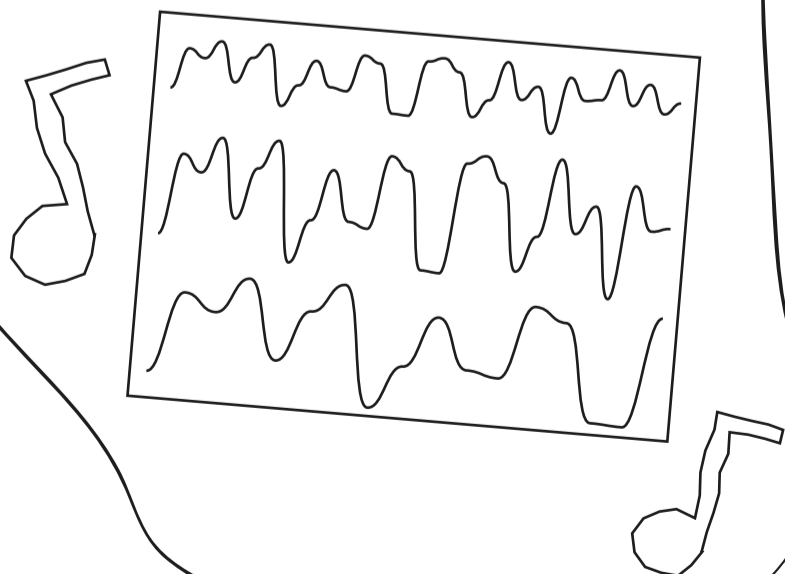


Use Pyka Loop to record your instrument sounds, and maybe add some words too!



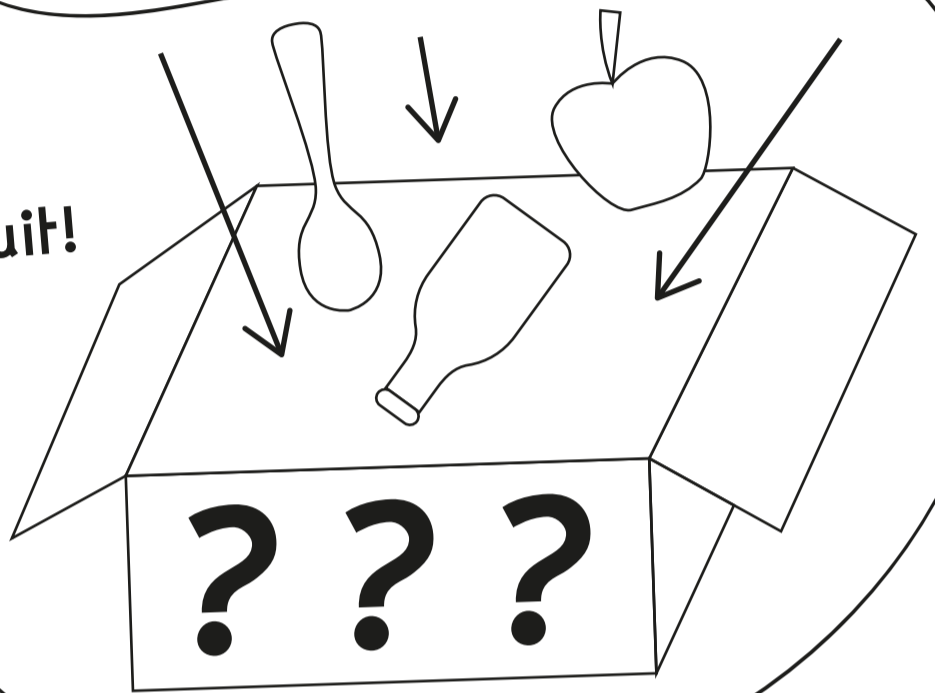

Use the app to layer the sounds, and you have created your own track!

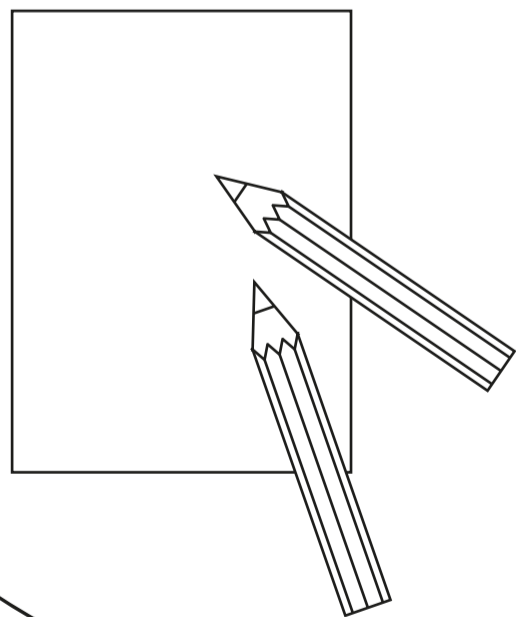
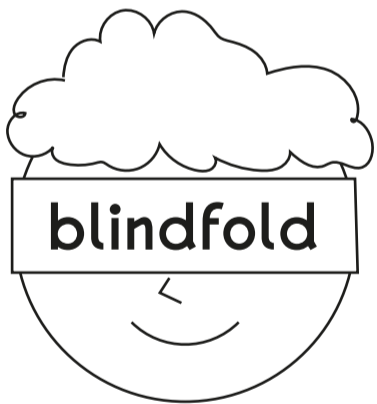


Mystery drawings ? ? ?

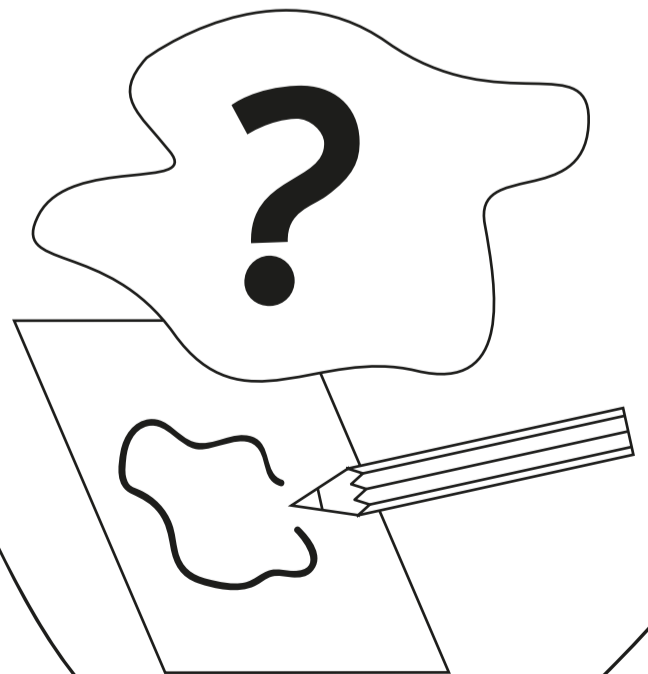
Ask a grown up to collect some safe, random objects from around the house and put them in a box. Some ideas include kitchen utensils and fruit!



Sit down with pens/crayons and paper directly in front of you, then put a blindfold on - this could be a scarf wrapped around your head!

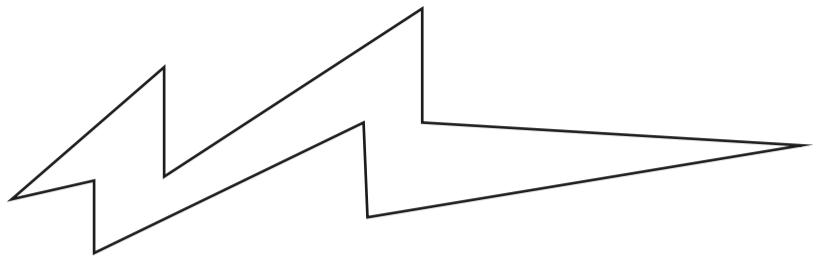

What interesting results have you got?

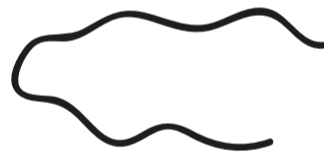
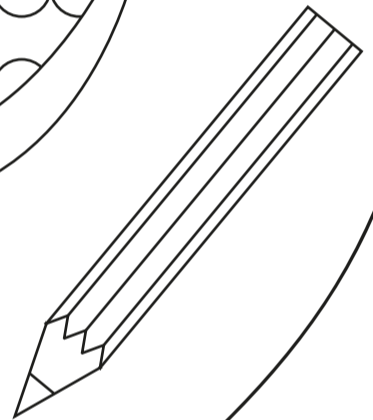
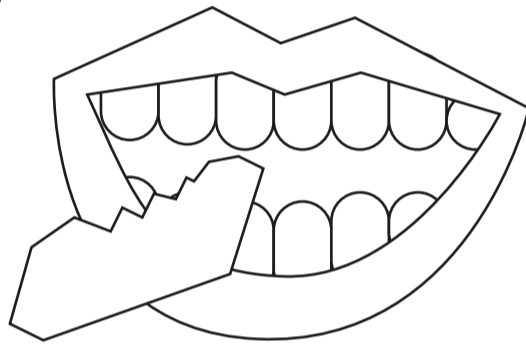
Drawing Tastes
